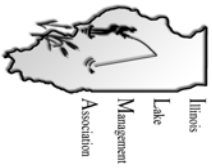

How to write a fundable 319 grant

Morton Arboretum—1:00 pm - 5:00 pm

This workshop will provide instruction on writing a fundable 319 grant. There will also be representatives from the IEPA and USEPA talking about the status of the 319 grant program. In addition, the host of this workshop, the Morton Arboretum, will provide their insight on how they successfully received a 319 grant. Weather permitting there may also be a tour of the grounds. The Arboretum is 3 miles from the hotel.

Natural Lawn Care Basics

Holiday Inn Select—1:00 pm - 4:00 pm

This workshop will show how to grow a sustainable, natural lawn—one that both looks good, saves money and helps our lakes. You will discover the health & environmental impacts of lawns, the natural lawn care difference and what it means to you, how to grow a healthy, natural lawn, and what to expect from 'organic' products. Lawn care around lakes will also be highlighted. In addition, a representative from the Soil and Water Conservation District will give a presentation about soil testing.
